The Staff and Pastoral Council are planning for **celebrating our return**, as a community, to our beautiful chapel for safe, in-person worship.



This will take place sometime in the early Fall.

We hope to acknowledge many dimensions of what these last fourteen pandemic months have meant: the grieving, the loss, the mourning, what we have learned, how our faith has grown stronger, and how, committed, we intend to gather.

Soon we will be **sending out a survey** to take a pulse of our community.

WAYS OF GIVING
