What is the Annual Paulist Appeal?


The Annual Paulist Appeal, which takes place each January, provides annual financial support for our L day-to-day operations such as vocations outreach; formation and education of our seminarians and novices; and our ministries, offices and programs. The Annual Paulist Appeal provides a base-level funding which allows these Paulist initiatives to do their good work from year to year.

The *Hope for the Future* campaign focuses on long-term, strategic priorities which can only be addressed through an extraordinary fundraising effort. It is the Paulists' first capital campaign in roughly 15 years. Together, the two efforts will strengthen Paulist ministry centers and parishes this year and for vears to come.

THE ADULT EDUCATION COMMITTEE HOSTS A PRESENTATION ON "A SYNOD ON SYNODALITY"


On't miss this historic opportunity!
