PASTORAL COUNCIL ELECTIONS

Are you a member of the Paulist Center who is looking for an opportunity to serve our Community? If so, **please consider running for the Pastoral Council!**

The Pastoral Council will be holding elections this spring for a few new members to **join the Council in September**, as we have our annual turnover for this two-year commitment.

Members meet once a month for an hour and a half to oversee maintaining the vision of the Paulist Center Community and advising the Staff on directions and initiatives.

Here is the Pastoral Council Candidate Checklist

- ✓ Consider the reasons you wish to serve and write up a 1-page statement.
- ✓ Obtain 25 “wet” or electronic endorsements from Paulist Center Community Members on your own Paulist Center Community Pastoral Council Nomination Petition.
- ✓ Submit a photo of yourself, along with the 1-page statement and the completed Nomination Petition to Amy Logan (alogan@erols.com)
- ✓ Elections will be held mid-May over 2 weekends. You will be invited to attend the Pastoral Council meeting in August when the retiring members depart and the new members join, which is typically referred to as the “Hello – Goodbye” meeting. The first official meeting of your 2-year term is in September 2022.
