2022 LAY MINISTRY SCHOLARSHIP

The Paulist Center offers a **grant of \$700 - \$1,000** to an active Roman Catholic lay student.

The grant is to be applied to **tuition for a first level graduate theological or pastoral degree program** (M.Div, MTS, MA in Pastoral Ministry, or equivalent).

The award is open to any lay person after successful completion of her/his first year of a master's-level degree program in a Boston Theological Institute (BTI) school.
