MARRIAGE PREPARATION PROGRAM LOOKING FOR VOLUNTEERS

We really **need your help** with our Marriage Preparation program! It is a great spiritual gift to 400-600 couples each year. The Paulist Center is one of a few institutions in the Archdiocese of Boston that is permitted to present "**Transformed in Love**", the Archdiocese's Marriage preparation program. We conduct sessions in person for up to 50 couples during the months of May through October and on-line (via Zoom) from November through April.



Paulist Center couples who volunteer for this ministry find it very rewarding. It's also a major source of new members and outside income for our community.

COMMMUNITY GIFT

The Paulist Center gives 5% of our annual offertory to 52 other charitable organizations with missions consonant with our own. These organizations receive an equal amount from our annual offertory.



The weekend of June 29 and 30 we raise up National CARES Mentoring Movement - their mission is to secure, heal and transform the lives of impoverished Black children by inspiring, recruiting and mobilizing masses of caring Black men and women to mentor and nourish them.

The weekend of **July 6 and 7** we raise up **Angel Flight**. This organization coordinates free air and ground transportation for medical patients whose financial resources would not otherwise enable them to receive treatment or diagnosis, or who live in rural areas without access to commercial airlines.
