

HELP US KEEP THE MARRIAGE PREP CLASSES GOING

or over 30 years, the Paulist Center has offered a marriage preparation program, highly rated by participants from across the Archdiocese.

We continue that history as a site for the Archdiocese of Boston's program, *Transformed in Love*.



Currently, we offer the program 11 months a year. This exposure helps the Boston Catholic community see how special the Paulist Center is and the program is an important source of income for the Center. Without it, we would need one or two more events like

the auction every year.

A devoted core team of couples gets smaller as people move to new cities or take on new responsibilities in their lives.

We invite married couples, especially those married 15 years or less, to consider being part of the team. The commitment would be a half-day, one or two Saturdays per year, to share your married-life experience with engaged couples. The curriculum is well structured and teaching materials already exist. It requires very little lecture; you set up each topic with a few minutes of material and then share some personal lessons and stories. Our current team couples love the experience! It gives them a chance to give back to the community and renew their love for each other in the process. They will guide you through the orientation and start-up.
